

Dear Friends,

This promise of God was such a blessing to me during last year when I was prayerfully considering leaving *Answers in Genesis* and starting this ministry. The Lord has been faithful and as I look back over the last 12 months, I can see that he has had plans for Irene and me and that he has provided for us and that he has not let harm come upon us. He has also provided for us in ways we could not have imagined – we want to thank you for the part you have played in this provision, both in your gifts and also in your prayers.

Speaking Ministry

Since our last newsletter, we have been busy travelling around ministering in various churches. Since the beginning of April, I have ministered in 18 churches, led a three day conference and Irene and I have appeared on two *Talk God* programmes on Genesis TV. We have covered almost 1,200 miles every month with our ministry as we have taken meetings in Cornwall, Somerset, South and West Wales, Monmouthshire, the North and East Midlands, North Yorkshire and London.

The meetings in Bodmin, Cornwall were particularly encouraging as several churches got together to organise the meetings which were held in several different venues. It is good when like-minded churches can work together for the Lord.

In a similar vein, one of the things that has pleased me is to have shared a platform with Geoff Chapman of the Creation Resources Trust on a couple of occasions. The reason I am so pleased with this is that so many creation ministries will not co-operate with each other and will not share platforms.

I spent a very interesting couple of days as a guest speaker at the Heath Christian Church in Cardiff. I spoke to a group of international students at the University on the Friday evening – there were atheists, Buddhists, hard-line Communists, Muslims as well as a few Christians present and they all listened attentively. On the Saturday morning I held a *workshop* at the church –giving a series of illustrated talks under the general title of "What About Origins?" I gave four 20 minutes talks followed by a 10 minutes or so discussion. The topics I covered

On Saturday 30th May, we joined several hundred people in London to celebrate the sixth anniversary of the ministry of Revelation and Genesis TV. It was a great privilege to be numbered with the other presenters and we were truly humbled by the reception and encouragement that we received. Do pray for this TV ministry – in particular for Howard and Lesley Conder as they endeavour to keep these TV stations on air. Please also pray for the many people who work on these stations – some "behind the scenes" and others as presenters. Most are volunteers, like us, who receive nothing for the work they do on these stations. Their desire (and ours) is to bring the gospel by all possible means to the greatest number of people.
