

Dear Friends,



## Real Jurassic Park?




*Baby Mammoth*

According to an article in the *Daily Mail* on 18 January 2011, scientists in Japan are attempting to bring the woolly mammoth back from the dead. From the remains of a woolly mammoth which is preserved in the Siberian ice, they are going to take a sample which is rich in DNA.

They will then inject the DNA into an empty egg taken from an elephant. After triggering the growth and cell division, they will then implant the developing embryo into a surrogate mother elephant. They hope that the first baby mammoths will be born in four to five years' time.

## Bible Doubters Defeated Again

One of the myths that is taught in so many Theological Institutions and Bible Colleges is that the books of the Old Testament were written by Jewish Scholars when they were in exile in Babylon. Modern academics maintain that they have identified three different sources of the Pentateuch and have designated them J, E and P. It must be pointed out that this is a hypothesis and that no documents have ever been found which substantiate this claim about these three hypothetical sources.


The so-called Aaronic Blessing is found in Numbers 6: 24-26. It is taught in many theological schools and seminaries that this is part of the Bible that is from the "P" source and it was written in or after the Babylonian Exile. In 1979, however, two small silver scrolls were found with the bones of a person who had died and was buried in the land of Israel in the late-seventh century BC.

It took three years to unroll the larger of the two scrolls which was a mere three inches long. On this silver scroll was written the priestly benediction from Numbers chapter six. This proves conclusively that this part of Scripture was known to the people of the Kingdom of Judah **before** they were taken into exile in Babylon.

The discovery of this find and its significance was not published until 1989. The scrolls can be seen in the Israel Museum in Jerusalem.


## Out and About
